Please join us on Sunday at 10:30am for our next Virtual Sunday Service. This Sunday we will be taking a virtual communion together, so please get ready for this by setting aside some

bread and grape juice, or other drink if you do not have this. Let's not be religious about this. The spiritual act is remembering, not having the right type of bread, or a particular type of drink. Let's remember Ramon's challenging, yet liberating, message to us last year focussing on communion in the general context of eating together every day. Let's remember the almost mundane nature of what Jesus commanded, albeit loaded with spiritual significance. So, with this in mind, let's observe the context of 1 Corinthians 10:31 (So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God), when we practice 1 Corinthians 11:26 (For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes). Full instructions on what to do will be given on Sunday so this will still be reverent, and orderly. I hope and believe our sense of togetherness will be enhanced, not diminished, by this shared experience.
