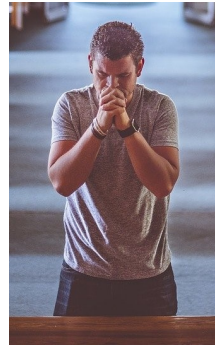

Day 1, Thursday 21, 11.30 – 12.30: DCF Prayer meeting. Please contact Jane for the password.

Day 2, Friday 22, 10.00 – 10.40: Praying for Muslims during their fasting month. Contact Jane for link to join.

Day 3, Saturday 23: Ring a friend and pray together over the phone.

Day 4, Sunday 24, 10.30 – or later: Tune into the DCF Sunday service on the DCF website (see notice sheet) prayer in the service will include this initiative. If you can't access the website, you can ring 0800 804 8044 to access the Daily Hope line. Press 1 for a well-known hymn that you can sing along to. This is followed by a short word on an attribute of God dealt with in the hymn. The hymn is sung a second time followed by prayer. Press 4 for other options including Anglican services.

Day 5, Monday 25, 9.00 – 10.00: Praying together using WhatsApp. Contact Graham to join.

Day 6, Tuesday 26, 9.00 – 10.00: SLT led prayer via ZOOM. See notice sheet for link to join.

Day 7, Wednesday 27: Why not try getting as many of your household praying together as possible, especially if you've never done this before? It might be best to keep it short and interesting if it's a first time. If you are living alone, why not pray over the phone with a friend?

Day 8, Thursday 28, 11.30 – 12.10: praying for the nation and beyond. Contact Jane for link to join.

Day 9, Friday 29, 10.00 – 10.40: Praying for Muslims during their fasting month. Contact Jane for link to join.

Day 10, Saturday 30: Why not ring a neighbour and ask them what they would like you to pray for them?
