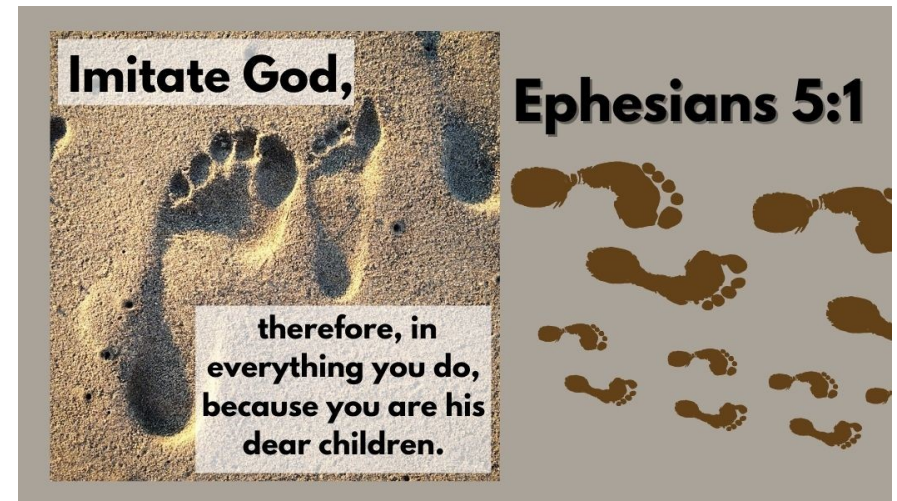

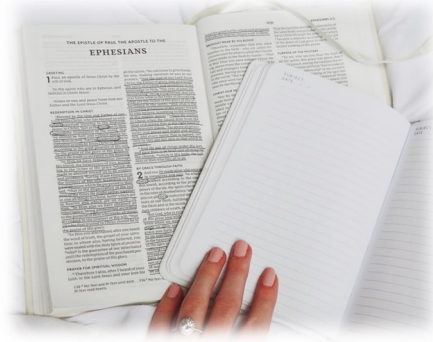

- Please pray that the authorities do not try to stop the event if we happen to be out of lockdown, but in Tier 3, on 20th December. Please pray that we remain in Tier 2 or that the authorities agree to find ways to allow the event to happen, with extra safety measures, rather than stopping it altogether.

- Please pray that we can fit in large numbers of cars and that the event is fully booked.
- Please pray that the schools agree to get involved by pre-recording some agreed Christian content on video. Please pray that this succeeds in getting parents and grandparents there on the 20th.
- Please pray for the church to step up and provide event marshals, health and safety champions, musicians and a follow-up team, as well as supporting the event wholeheartedly by booking in themselves and telling their friends and family.
- Please pray against torrential rain or high winds on the day.
- Please pray for more funds to come in to spread the financial burden.
- Please pray for the Gospel to be preached clearly and boldly as the Spirit leads in the moment
- Please pray for those watching on Facebook Live (or YouTube after the event), that the impact of the message would be multiplied a thousandfold
- Please pray for other churches looking to 'go and do likewise' this Christmas, especially in Somerset and the North West
