

Palm Sunday Questions

Question Time 1

- When have you found yourself caught up in the midst of a like-minded crowd, in a moment of excitement, waving your hands in the air and shouting what everyone else is shouting?
- When have you found it easy to offer something to God because everyone else around you is doing the same religious thing?
- When have you wanted Jesus to be someone he's not?

Question Time 2

- What outrages you about the cross?
- Why did Jesus have to die for you?
- Who are you that God needed to go to such extreme measures to save you?

Question Time 3

- Who is it that you find it hardest to forgive: yourself for what you have done, or not done, or God for allowing you to go through such suffering?
- What would your life look like if you allowed yourself to completely believe that Jesus has obliterated your past and concreted your future?
- When have you allowed self-pity to cause you to expect from other people what only God can provide?

Question Time 4

- How could you use communion this week as an opportunity to preach the gospel to yourself and to those around you? How could you remember Easter through communion?
- Based on three meals a day, you have 21 opportunities a week to remember the Gospel of Jesus Christ. How could such an expanded view of 'communion' transform your everyday life with the truth of the gospel?

Question Time 5

- In Christ, we move from the pigsty to the party, from absolute lostness to adoption into the Father's household. How do you respond to God's excessive, 'over-the-top' love for you?
- What would it mean to truly trust someone who loves you this much? Where could that kind of faith take you?

Answer these simple questions for yourself as you consider the cross of Christ:

- Who is God?
- What has He done?
- Who are we in light of what He has done?
- How then should we live?
