Gift Aid Small Donation Scheme (GASDS)

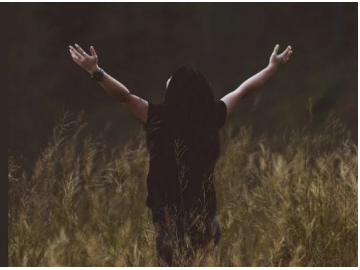
When we were able to meet on a Sunday morning, the folks who used to make their weekly offerings in the collection bags will no doubt remember that under the GASDS scheme we were able to claim the equivalent of gift aid on offerings of less than £30. HMRC have recognised that Churches have been unable to meet up and therefore lost out on the GADSD scheme. They have now said that if anyone puts a cash sum in an envelope with a note to say that it represents what they would have put in the offering bag then we can claim GASDS e.g.



Enclosed is £50 which represents 10 weeks at £5 per week. Hopefully we can then claim up to another £2000 from the Government. If anyone wishes to do this, then please let Alan have the envelope at his home address. The payment needs to be anonymous and in cash only. If you have any questions, please speak to Alan.
